### Atlanta Investment Adviser Brings Wall Street Tech to Georgia University Students with New Quantitative Fellowship

*Foxholm Financial offers juniors and seniors at Georgia universities an academic-credit internship with full credential sponsorship and hands-on fintech experience.*

**ATLANTA, GA, February 17, 2026:** Foxholm Financial today announced the launch of its [Quantitative Investment Fellowship](#), a 12-week, for-credit internship for college juniors and seniors. The program kicks off with a selective Summer 2026 Pilot Cohort, followed by the full Fall 2026 session. This remote program replaces the traditional finance internship model with a rigorous curriculum in Python, cloud infrastructure, and open-source data analytics.

Addressing the widening gap between academic theory and fintech reality, the fellowship offers a structured pre-professional experience mirroring institutional operations. Strictly non-commercial, fellows are prohibited from sales activities. Instead, they work directly with firm leadership to build proof of concept investment dashboards, analyze model portfolio risk, and document cloud data infrastructure.

"The most valuable asset for a modern financial professional is a robust technical toolkit. We designed this fellowship to bridge the gap between academic theory and the actual data infrastructure that powers intelligent investing," said [Robert Stowe, M.Ed.](#), President of Foxholm Financial. Stowe, a Senior Engineering Leader with over 15 years of fintech experience, shapes the program as a true educational curriculum using an open-source, OS-agnostic tech stack.
